### Eternal Wisdom And Principles In Government

"I, wisdom, dwell together with prudence; I possess knowledge and discretion. To fear the LORD is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech. Counsel and sound judgment are mine; I have understanding and power. By me kings reign and rulers make laws that are just; by me princes govern, *and all nobles who rule on earth.*<sup>1</sup> I love those who love me, and those who seek me find me. With me are riches and honor, enduring wealth and prosperity. My fruit is better than fine gold; what I yield surpasses choice silver. I walk in the way of righteousness, along the paths of justice, bestowing wealth on those who love me and making their treasuries full. ### John Adams



"The general Principles, on which the Fathers achieved Independence, were... ..the general Principles of Christianity... Now I will avow, that I then believed, and now believe, that those general Principles of Christianity, are as eternal and immutable, as the Existence and attributes of God..." [Note: Emphasis is Adam's.]

- John Adams: Educator, Attorney, Jurist, Diplomat; delegate to the Continental Congress where he signed the Declaration of Independence; appointed Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Massachusetts; delegate to the Massachusetts constitutional convention and wrote most of the first draft of the Massachusetts Constitution; served two terms as Vice-President under President George Washington; second President of the United States.

who:

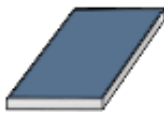
follow Jesus and have a Biblical

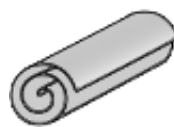
