who:

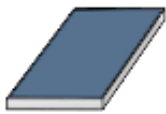
follow Jesus and have a Biblical

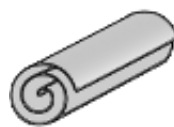

Because News is RSS syndicated, many times articles that would be more permanent will be published under News, and at a later date be moved into the Articles section.

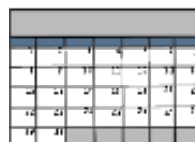
