who:

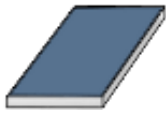
follow Jesus and have a Biblical

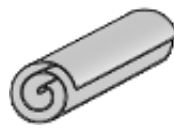

Are you wondering “where did that News article go?” Older News articles are still available in the News Archive.

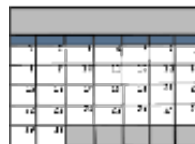
