
Frequently Asked Questions

Why does the word sitemap appear above the side block?

The site is designed, for the most part, to be able to navigate without pictures turned on. At the same time, the drop-down menu does not show up with images turned off. This site-map link above the side block allows a person who is viewing the website without pictures a way to navigate through the site. In addition, the site is also designed to be mobile aware. It does not show the side block in mobile browsers, and has a different menu. Feel free to let us know how the mobile browser functionality works for you.
